



EVENT WEATHER INSURANCE PROGRAM

The Lititz Summer Showcase
July 11 – 12, 2026

How It Works

Q: Am I required to purchase event cancellation insurance to participate in the Lititz Summer Showcase?

A: No. This is an optional program set in place to safeguard your team and its entry fees.

Q: If I do purchase a policy, and the event is canceled or curtailed due to weather, will I get a refund?

A: Yes! See pages 2 and 3, below, for details.

Q: What is the cost?

A: The policy rate is a flat 10% of your specific Lititz Summer Showcase age group entry fee.

Q: How do I purchase this policy?

A: Within the GotSport application to the Lititz Summer Showcase, on the final page of the application.

Q: What if I already registered but did not opt to purchase the policy, and now I want to?

A: That's easy. You may go back into your application and purchase it. [CLICK HERE](#).

Q: Is there a time limit on when I can purchase the policy?

A: Yes. **To be valid, all policies must be purchased 15 days before the start of the event.**

For the Lititz Summer Showcase that means you must purchase the insurance policy by 11:00pm EST on Friday, June 26, 2026. You cannot purchase the event insurance policy after that point and should the event be canceled or curtailed you would not receive any refund of team entry fees or credits to future events.

Q: What does the policy cover?

A: This policy covers all unsafe weather-related conditions, ensuring teams are protected from the unexpected, including Heat, Rain, Ice, Snow, Hail, Smoke, Hurricanes, Tornadoes, Earthquakes, and Unplayable Venues.

Here's how it works for teams that have purchased USSCI - VI policies:

Full Refund for Pre-Tournament Cancellations:

If the event is canceled before the tournament starts due to weather conditions, your insured team will receive 100% of the non-refundable registration fee back.

Pro-Rated Refund for Mid-Tournament Cancellations / Curtailments:

If the tournament is forced to cancel after it has started, the insured team will receive a refund based on the number of games guaranteed versus the number of games played. This ensures you only pay for the games you've played and not a penny more. Teams are guaranteed three (3) games during the Lititz Summer Showcase. Each game of the three (3) games is worth 33% of the entry fee. Any game missed means your insured team gets a 33% refund. There is no refund if a "Final", or fourth (4th), or extra, game is canceled. Once a team has played their three (3) guaranteed games the event is considered complete from an insurance perspective, and teams are not eligible for any type of refund.

Teams who are eligible for refunds should see their refunds issued back within one (1) month of the conclusion of the Lititz Summer Showcase.

Reimbursement of entry fees, for eligible teams, will be remitted directly to the individual policy holder that purchased the Event Cancellation Insurance. All purchased policies are a contract between USSCI – VI (US Sports Club Insurance – Vertical Insure) and the purchaser. PA Classics will not be the issuer of refunded entry fees, only USSCI - VI will be.

All entrant teams have the choice to purchase event cancellation insurance, or not to. In the event of a weather-related cancellation or curtailment, teams that have purchased the event policy will be refunded, up to 100% of their entry fees, depending on how many games were or were not played.

Refunds will only be granted to teams that have individually purchased a policy with US Sports Club Insurance – Vertical Insure (USSCI - VI). Teams that opted NOT to purchase an Event Cancellation Insurance policy will not receive any direct monetary reimbursement of their entry fees.

Under no circumstances, whatsoever, will Pennsylvania Classics AC, PA Classics USA Corp. or any of its Directors, Board Members, Tournament Directors, or Event Staff be responsible for any team or individual expenses (hotel, travel, food, etc.) incurred by any team, team member/staff, or associated family, due to an event or games cancellation, weather, COVID-19, or otherwise.
